PROCLAMATION NO. 22

DECLARING SATURDAY, AUGUST 30, 1986, AS A NON-WORKING
SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY, IN SAN JUAN, METRO MANILA.

WHEREAS, the 90th anniversary of the "Battle of
Pinaglabanan, an important event in our struggle for
freedom, falls on August 30, 1986;


WHEREAS, said historical event is of special signi-

ceremonies;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, CORAZON C. AQUINO, President of
